ANNUAL REPORT 2025

The year 2024–2025 has been a year of steady growth, remarkable achievements, and continued commitment to excellence at the school. With a strong focus on academic rigor, value-based education, and all-round development, the school has once again upheld its reputation as a center of learning and character building.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

In the **Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (SSCE) 2025**, a total of **97 students** appeared. We are proud to announce that **Debarghya Samanta** emerged as the **school topper with an** outstanding score of **95.6%**, followed by **Tyasa Maiti** with **94.2%** and **Monish Mondal** with **93.2%**. A total of **11 students** secured **above 90%**, reflecting the consistent academic excellence of our students and the dedicated efforts of our faculty.

In the **Secondary School Examination (SSE) 2025**, **121 students** appeared. **Enakshi Das** and **Shrestha Adak** jointly secured the **top position** with an impressive **97.8%**. They were followed by **Samarpita Mandi** and **Shreyasi Nandi**, each scoring **97.2%**, and **Arkadeep Bar**, who secured **96.8%**. Notably, **42 students** achieved **above 90%**, a testament to the hard work, discipline, and determination of our students.

PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

The students of the school continued to excel in **national-level competitive examinations** during the academic year 2024–2025. In the **JEE Advanced 2025**, **2 students** successfully qualified, while **15 students** cleared the **JEE Mains**. Additionally, **5 students** achieved success in the **NEET 2025** examination.

ACCOLADES IN SPORTS:

The performance of the students in the **DAV National Sports 2025** was truly commendable and brought great pride to the school. A total of **12 boys** participated in various swimming events under the **Under-17 and Under-19** categories, securing a total of **3 gold, 7 silver**, and **2 bronze** medals.

The participation of **girls** in the **Under-17 and Under-19 swimming categories** was equally remarkable. Out of **14 entries**, they secured **1 gold, 9 silver**, and **4 bronze** medals, showcasing their talent and determination.

In **rhythmic gymnastics**, **Srija Mahato** emerged as the undisputed champion, winning **5 gold medals** in five different events, a phenomenal individual achievement.

In **karate (girls' category)**, **Bristy Khatun** brought laurels to the school by winning a **silver medal**.

In the **Under-19 chess category**, our students secured **3 silver medals**, reflecting their strategic skills and mental discipline.

In total, the school won an impressive tally of **35 medals**, including **9 gold, 18 silver**, and **6 bronze** medals.

We conducted **Annual Sports Meet** and different **Inter-House tournaments**. The increase participation of our students in various sports activities reflected the school's strong emphasis on sports and the holistic development of students through discipline, dedication, and sportsmanship.

RECOGNITION AND ACHIEVEMENTS

A commendable number of our students actively participated in various competitions held both within the school and at national and inter-school levels, earning accolades for their exceptional performances.

Surya Kanti Ghosh, Amarjit Sahu, and Samarpita Mandi secured positions among the **Top 100** in the **Bhubaneswar Zone** in the **Aryabhatta Ganit Challenge 2023**.

Banhishikha Mandal of VID was selected to attend the **National Level Camp of Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan 2024–25**, marking a significant academic achievement.

A team of six students represented our school in the Group Folk Dance Competition organized by the Sahodaya School Complex and secured the Runner-Up position.

Students from Classes III to V participated in the Storytelling Competition and Bengali Rhymes conducted by the Renaissance Artists and Writers Association, Paschim Medinipur, achieving ranks within the top six positions.

Since the academic session 2017–18, our school has consistently been honoured with The Telegraph School Award for Excellence in Academics, a testament to our sustained academic commitment.

In addition, many of our students attained notable ranks in various Olympiads at the international, national, and state levels, including SOF and DAV Olympiads, and were awarded medals and certificates of excellence in recognition of their achievements.

ANNUAL EVENTS AND CELEBRATIONS:

To commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, DAV Public School, Midnapore observed Rashtriya Ekta Diwas by organizing a “Run for Unity.” The school also celebrated important national and international days such as World Earth Day, World Environment Day, International Yoga Day and World Education Day. A Cleanliness Drive was also conducted as part of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan initiative.

Veer Gatha, a Government of India initiative, witnessed enthusiastic participation from our students in various competitions organized to pay tribute to the valour and sacrifices of national leaders and martyrs.

The birth anniversaries of great visionaries— including Mahatma Gandhi, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, Rabindranath Tagore, Swami Vivekananda, Pandit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Swami Dayanand Saraswati, and Mahatma Hansraj —were celebrated to honour their extraordinary contributions to society and the nation.

Our students also participated in the **Vedic Chetna Shivir** held at DAV Public School Pandaveshwar where they imbibed Vedic values and won prizes for their commendable performance.

Reaffirming our commitment to a greener planet, the school organized year-round **Vanmahotsav** activities by planting trees within the school campus, encouraging environmental awareness and responsibility among students.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

To hone the latent skills and showcase the talent of the students, a host of co-curricular activities were organised during the course of this year. Inter-House competitions such as **Quiz, Folk Song, Classical Dance, Spell Bee, Essay Writing, Drawing, Rangoli Making** were conducted to promote the spirit of participation among every student.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Our school also provides training and guidance to the **Scouts & Guides** on a regular basis.

The students of **ECO CLUB** and **SCIENCE CLUB** carried out various activities throughout the year under the guidance of the teachers.

DAV believes in the pursuit of excellence. To enhance teaching standards, Capacity Building Programmes were organized by DAV CAE, and CBSE to equip teachers with modern pedagogical tools and methodologies. Faculty members from each subject were sent to Delhi to undergo specialized training and were designated as Resource Persons, enabling them to disseminate the acquired knowledge to their fellow teachers for continued professional growth.

Selected teachers from our school also attended a two-day Training of Trainers (ToT) Certification Course, organized by CBSE and developed by the Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM), Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India. This training was specifically designed to prepare nominated CBSE Resource Persons for future academic mentorship roles.
